TASTING NOTES

The 2013 Patriarch is deep ruby in color and offers a beautiful bouquet of aromas, including blackberry, black cherry, cedar, cloves and a hint of cocoa. It's full bodied and powerful, yet also friendly on the palate with flavors of juicy plums and an elegant mouthfeel with high tannins. The finish leaves a long and lasting impression with a subtle freshness that is welcomed back. Very Debonair.

VINEYARDS

Winston Hill Vineyard is located in the eastern side of the Napa Valley's Rutherford appellation along the Vaca Mountain range; the hand-terraced vine rows have southwestern exposure and consist of well-drained volcanic and sandstone soils that rise nearly 500 feet from the valley floor.
